BIELSKI AND LEWICKI CHOSEN AS OUTSTANDING ATHLETES FOR 1954

After much groundwork had been laid and after great and careful deliberation, the Ukrainian Youth's League of North America testimonial committee has decided to honor Richard Bielski (6'0"-210 lbs) of Maryland University as the "Outstanding Ukrainian College Athlete for 1954" and Danny Lewicki (5'9"-165 lbs.) of the N.Y. Rangers hockey club as the "Outstanding Ukrainian Professional Athlete for 1954."

Both athletes were chosen only after much debate and discussion had been held on the relative merits of the many contenders in both the "amateur" and "professional" categories.

The deciding factor which weighed heavily in Bielski's favor was his tremendous job of all-around playing in the recent 2 North-South games—one in Miami where he was the "Outstanding player of the game" (practically all 48 players were All-American mentions) while leading the Gray (South) team to victory on Christmas night by a score of 20-17—and in Mobile 2 weeks later, scoring the winning TD against the North, 12-6.

In the "professional" category, Danny Lewicki of the N. Y. Rangers, hockey club was likewise selected only after much discussion.

Lewicki, whose fiery Ukrainian Kozak temperament kept him in hot water with his Toronto Maple Leaf bosses a couple of seasons ago with the result that he had difficulty with that club, has blossomed forth into a great scoring star with the New York club.
