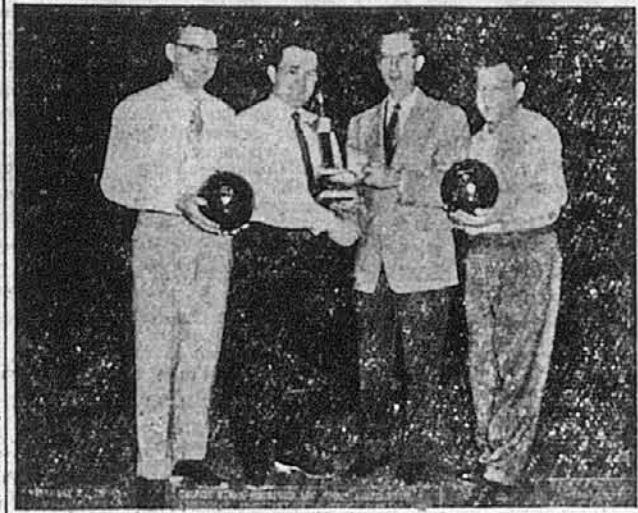
UYL-NA CORNER
